Case Management/Alternative Treatments

The Executive Committee designates the Executive Director along with the relevant third party administrator and/or pharmacy benefits manager to engage in case management activities and employ alternative treatments when there is a reasonable expectation of cost effective results while maintaining the quality of care.

Such may require the alteration or waiver of provisions of the Plan. As noted in the Plan document such actions are not precedent setting, in that each alteration or waiver of the provisions of the Plan are determined on a case by case basis taking into account the merits of each case and the expected outcomes. Incentives to induce compliance with treatments or to offset patient costs may also be included.
