Policy No. 314

Charter Schools

The Tri-County Schools Insurance Group (TCSIG), recognizing that Schools or Districts may apply for Charter School Status pursuant to Ed. Code 47600 et.seq., will consider providing coverage upon application within Tri-County Schools Insurance Group's self-insured retention providing that certain minimum risk management standards are followed. These standards include but are not limited to:

- 1. District administrative regulations and rules regarding risk management and safety.
- 2. Programs, transportation, and facility use that are consistent with District policies.
- 3. Hiring and termination policies and procedures that are consistent with the District's other schools, including full compliance with all nondiscriminatory laws and statues.
- 4. Indemnification clauses.
- 5. Claim reporting.
- 6. Safety inspection compliance.

The District shall provide necessary documentation including the school's Charter application, prior to consideration by the Tri-County Schools Insurance Group Executive Committee.

If coverage is accepted by Tri-County Schools Insurance Group, then Tri-County Schools Insurance Group will submit information to its excess carriers for them to either approve or not approve coverage for their layers.
